What is a Rehabilitation Support Worker?

The Rehabilitation Support Worker is a non-regulated health professional that provides direct therapy and transitional support to individuals recovering from an acquired brain injury and/or serious trauma. These supports are provided under the direction of regulated health professionals, and are provided in a variety of settings.

Emphasis is placed on: establishing therapeutic rapport, communicating effectively, prioritizing ongoing activities, and developing practical strategies.

TYPES OF INJURIES/SYMPTOMS

When do you need a Rehabilitation Support Worker?

BEHAVIOUR CHALLENGES

- When neither family nor an individual are able to manage behaviours resulting from the traumatic event (i.e. motor vehicle accident)
- When an individual cannot return to pre-accident levels of activity/work due to behaviors (poor judgment, anger management challenges, disinhibition, lack of initiation)

COGNITIVE CHALLENGES

• When an individual is exhibiting deficits in executive functions such as memory issues, poor planning and organization, and cannot manage day-to-day life independently

PHYSICAL CHALLENGES

• When physical injuries impede a client from participating in daily activities and experienced handson support is required to facilitate daily function

TRANSITION CHALLENGES

- When an individual requires support in discharge from hospital to home to establish daily routine and structure
- When an individual is returning to school, work or vocational activities and they are unable to manage transition independently
- When an individual is socially isolated and requires support to connect to community resources
